Americans Go In To Drive Out Japanese

"Heavy Fighting Is Still in Progrcss," Admiral King Announces

WASHINGTON.—(AP)—Admiral Ernest J. King, announced today that American forces had landed in the southeastern Solomon Islands with the purpose of driving out the Japanese and permanently occupying the strategic area in the southern Pacific.

The announcement was made in a statement which said that "heavy fighting is still in progress" and that the American units engaged so far have had at least one cruiser sunk and two cruisers, two destroyers and one transport damaged.

Information as to damage inflicted on the enemy is incomplete, King reported, but included "a large number of planes" as well as surface units "put out of action."
