Williams, 18-year-old member of the outlawed Irish Republican Army, was hanged in a heavily guarded jail for killing a policeman.

CAIRO. (AP) — British forces were locked heavily in battle with Axis armor all day yesterday in the southern sector of the Egyptian front, the British Headquarters announced today.

The war bulletin, issued jointly by the headquarters and the RAF, said United States Army Air Force planes participated in extensive air operations over the entire area in which an Allied battle line was braced against the expected shock of Field Marshal Rommel's powerful tank forces, again trying to grind forward toward Alexandria, the Nile and the Suez Canal.
