American Heavy Bomber Force Has Doubled Its Size Since March

By LEWIS HAWKINS

LONDON — (AP)— The American bomber force in England is increasing at a rate between 15 and 30 per cent monthly and by the end of this Summer will approximate the bomber strength of the RAF, Maj-Gen. Ira C. Eaker, commander of United States Army Air Forces in this theater, disclosed today.

Soon the American force will be strong enough to hit the Axis in Europe at three, four, five or more places in a single day. Eaker declared, with each fleet capable of obliterating any normal industrial target.

He disclosed that nearly 300 four-engined bombers participated in the American daylight raid on targets at St. Nasaire, Rennes and La Pallice in Prance on May 20.
