ALLIED HEADQUARTERS IN NORTH AFRICA—
(AP)—United States troops were overrunning the Axisear guard today in the vicinity of Milazzo, fourteen miles,
west of Messina, and it was officially stated that the end
of the Sicilian campaign "is now at hand."

The Americans, pushing up between twelve and fifteen
miles, advanced well beyond Barcellona to within heavy,
artillery range of Messina and it was assumed that this
