Fortresses Down 34 Nazi Planes

LONDON — (AP) — Fast British Mosquito bombers again attacked targets in Berlin last night while fighting struck at airfields and railway targets on the Continent, it was announced today.

The night raids followed blows by Allied planes, including American flying fortresses, against four of Germany's most important air bases in Holland and France yesterday.

Intruders last night attacked railway and airfield targets in France and Belgium. "Blisseng (Blüthen) and Giffen in Holland were battered by American Flying Fortresses late yesterday afternoon and 31 enemy fighters were shot down.

Japs Cling Desperately To Footholds In Solomons

Fight On Despite Lack of Supplies

YATES McDANIEL, ALI LIEBOWITZ, REPORTERS IN THE SOUTHWEST PACIFIC — (AP) — Japan's supply line has been cut in the Solomons and sorely strained in New Guinea—the right and left flanks of the Allied Pacific drive—and the resourceful enemy still has a precarious foothold on New Georgia and clings to Salamaua.

Reports in today's communiqué from both ends of the 150-mile battle are emphatic clearly by the jungle character of the Pacific war and the determination of the Japanese to make the most of the topography.
