

San Giovanni And Reggio Calabria In Invader's Hands-More Troops Pour Across Messina Strait

ALLIED HEADQUARTERS IN NORTH AFRICA—(AP)— British and Canadlas troops have clamped a firm hold on a ten-mile bridgehead between Regric Calabria and San Giovanni on the Italian toe, seizing both towns, and are plunging absed. Albeit Headquarters announced today.

Only weak opposition has been encountered along the coast since the firmsless vesterday morning, and many Italians aurrendered quickly.
