



### TWENTY FEET VISION

The system of judging the visual ability of children in our schools by having them read letters on a chart having them read letters on a chart twenty feet away is quite inadequate, it is a test that isn't logical. By this test is indged their ability to do things at twenty feet. Yet what they are doing hour after hour is to look at the printed page 11 to 16 inches away. While this is better than no test at all as it will pick up high errors of astigmatism, myopia (near sightledness) and hyperopia (farsightledness) it will not pick up low grade errors, which often greatly hamper the learning process. ing process

### PARENTS CAN MAKE

BETTER TESTS

Parents can make a much better test of their child's visual efficiency than the usual school test. Serutinize the next report card. See if grades are uniformly low. If so, it probably isn't a visual problem. If grades are tow in the subjects where concentration at book or desk is essential and grades are better in those subjects that do not need a concentration set definite. not need a concentration so definite, then you will have reason to believe that your child is visually ineffective.
