U. S. Losses Not High As Feared

LONDON — (AP) — U. S. Fifteenth Air Force heavy bombers from Italy apparently were striking Germany today as grey Wintry weather halted a two-day offensive by the British-based U. S. Eighth Air Force and the R.A.F.

Some 3,000 Planes Attacked


Some 3,000 planes had attacked synthetic oil plants in the Leipzig area and rail yards in Germany yesterday proved considerably less than originally announced.
