Invasion Casualty Report: 3,283 Americans Killed In Fighting in France

By DON WHITEHEAD WITH AMERICAN FORCES IN FRANCE, say the American Army had 3,283 killed and 12,600 wounded in opening the Western Front in Normandy, Lt. Gen. Omar N. Bradley said today.

The total of 15,883 casualties was for the first 11 days of the campaign, and included captured up to midnight last night, Gen. Bradley said.

Bradley's first words to the correspondents who gathered in the tent under the shade of a huge beech tree were in praise of the men and their leaders.
