

500 U.S. Heavy Bombers Join Attack On Retreat Routes; Romans Cheer Liberation

ALLIED HEADQUARTERS, NAPLES — (AP) — A welcome approaching hysteria showered down upon the Fifth Army in Captured Rome today as Allied troops surged into the town in ever growing numbers and rolled on across the Tiber in pursuit of the Jermans falling back to possible defense lines 150 miles northward.

With the major parts of two German armies, the Tenth and Fourteenth, already delared by Lt. Gen. Mark W. Clark to have been destroved, 500 heavy American bombers today joined a mighty attack on the retreat routes north of Rome.

While Romans cheered and sang after a night of liberation in which bare-chested partisans had joined Allied troops in ejecting the Germans and Fascists from the virtually undamaged city, the heavy bombers blasted railyards at Ferrara, Castel Maggiore, Bologna, Faenza and Forli.
