which went to the jury. Other defendants it acquitted.

Even so, it samply isn't arguable that either the cops (City, County and State Highway) are guilty of making capticlous arrests for drunken driving, else the court is guilty of brushing aside the testimony of the arresting officers and treating the offense, which is a serious one, with unbecoming lightness. The little reader may guess which is the more nearly true.

The best professional opinion is that sentle patients in general do not belong in the hospitals. And in this time, when there is a long waiting list of the mentally ill and wards are overflowing, seniles have become an acute problem.
