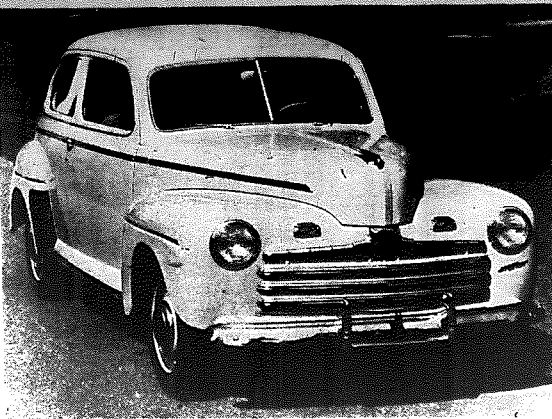

Fords Start Rolling Off Line; Hundreds To Be Made At Once

DETROIT—The Ford Motor Co. today began assembly line production of Ford cars at its Rouge plant and announced plans to build four new assembly plants as part of its \$150,000,000 postwar program.

Two of the new plants will be at St. Louis and Atlanta, Ga. Location of the others was not disclosed. In making this announcement today, Henry Ford II, executive vice-president of the company, said production plans call for separation of assembly of Ford and Mercury cars throughout the au-

Attacks Open

Bushfield Charges Charter Has Flaws

WASHINGTON—In one of the first open Senate breaks on the United Nations Charter, Senator Bushfield, Republican, South Dakota, declared today the document contains at least six flaws. These should be corrected, he told his colleagues, before the Charter is ratified.

Although the first-term Westerner asserted some of the provisions must be changed "for our national safety," he announced he would support the treaty because he could not face his soldier son "if I fail to do what I can to stop the senseless, maniacal slaughter and planned murder of my fellow men."

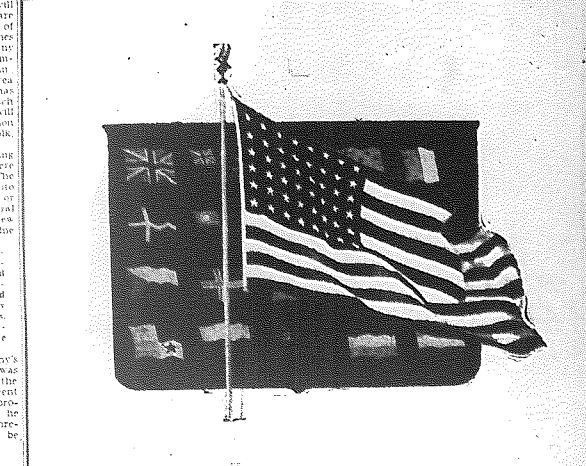
SENATE "FAULTS" In a Senate speech, Bushfield listed these as "the jurisdictional faults in the new treaty":

- 1. "It delegates power which we have no authority to delegate to the Security Council to declare war.
2. "It places our sovereignty in the hands of foreigners because we have only one vote out of a necessary total of seven.
3. "It seeks by implication to delegate power to the American member of the Security Council to vote us into war without reference to Congress.
4. "It grants to the Security Council power to regulate the size and kind of our armaments for national defense.
5. "It destroys the Monroe Doctrine, which is the only fixed foreign policy America has ever had and leaves that foreign policy to a council of foreign nations."
Bushfield said all the objections "can be corrected easily by the Senate" without harm to the treaty.
