MANILA — (AP) — General MacArthur today curtly ordered the Japanese to comply without further delay with his directive to send emissaries to Manila.

Tokyo, meanwhile, carried the quibbling over the pre-liminary peace conference into the second day.

The Allied Supreme Commander did not set a deadline for the departure of the Japanese envoys but indicated definitely he would tolerate no extended delay without good reason.
