New 'Second Front' Of Pacific War Opens

Russia's Scherian troops were reported invading pupper Manchuria at many points against the 2,000-mile frontier today as American air forces in China hammered at Japases withfrawal routes toward the new "second front" in the Pacific war.

Chinese parachite troops also were disclosed to have gone into action against the apunese in an effort to block any withfrawal northward.
