

the welfare fund, Lewis finds himself on the spot in these other respects—if the Friday strike threat materializes:

1. The Smith-Connally War Labor Disputes Act, under which the miners were struck last May 22, provides a \$5,000 fine or a year in jail or both. If it can be proved that Lewis—or any other union leader—induced the miners to stay home,
2. By following to the fore among union leaders planning a new round of wage demands, Lewis has risked making his own UMW a target of the GOP's rallying point for anti-labor legislation in the new Congress.
