"I was standing in the kitchen and when he came into the kitchen I reached back in the cabinet and got out a pistol that had been there ever since I moved into the place."

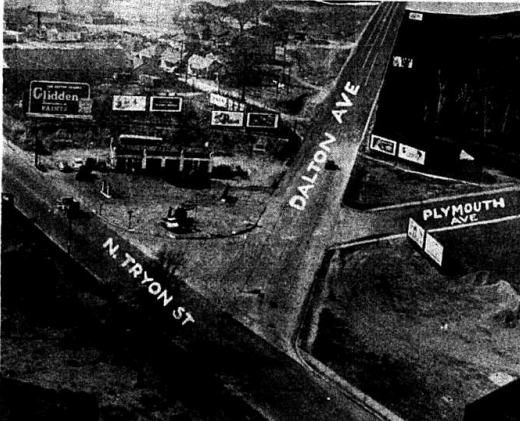
