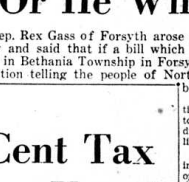

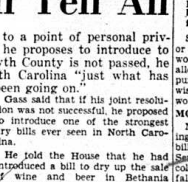
CROWDED HEARING—Firemen had to order spectators from the aisles of the Senate chamber during the closed shop debate in Raleigh yesterday.



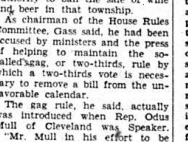
