The United States seeks to achieve that purpose with a proposed draft providing for collective sperations by a vote of two-thirds of the twenty-two American republics represented in the conference. Argentina has been employing various devices to obstruct or delay adoption of a treaty that would deprive her of the veto and deal a severe blow to her expansionist ambitions in South America. in South America.
