

U. S. Disarmament Has Halted, Dulles Tells Soviets

Delegate To U. N. Says America To Stay Strong

PARIS — (AP) — The United States told Russia to disarm and intend to be strong, for the benefit of both themselves and their friends.

Dulles termed "vicious ruse" Russia's charges that the United States is "in the process of disarming."

Dulles said "it is in part because the Security Council's power to decide is eroded by veto and the power to act is crippled."

Dulles said "it is in part because the threat is obviously continuing."

Dulles said the United States withdrew from the First and Second World Wars and that now were "pink panthers."

Dulles said "Why? Because they are afraid to let those findings go."

Man Slain In Waldorf Hotel

Small Girl Molested Enraged Father Kills Cripple In Jail Cell

SHARPSBURG, Pa.—An enraged father who believed his small daughter had been raped hurried into the jail here today and fatally shot the 17-year-old, congealed rap picker after summoning a police sergeant as witness.

The victim, William Moore, was shot twice in the heart. Police Sgt. Robert Antico said Nicholas Antico, 37, Sharpburg bartender, fired the shots from a .22-30 revolver before Antico could prevent the tragedy.

Antico said Moore had been jailed on a charge of molesting his five-year-old daughter. County Detective George Wetzel said Antico would be charged with murder.

Antico was taken into the police station and asked the location of Moore's cell. Antico walked to the adjacent cell block and was arrested by Antico.

Antico was pronounced dead on arrival at St. Francis Hospital. Antico was removed to the county jail on a district attorney's detainer.

Antico, estranged from his wife has another daughter, 10. Both girls lived with their mother.

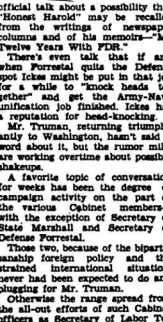

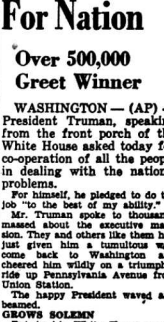
