Then we watched and saw what was happening. We became discouraged gradually as other organizations were formed. We heard mutterings against the United Nations and lost faith in its power.

DURING all of this time, however, our national representatives, realizing that we must have a short-range as well as a long-range economic aid policy with foreign nations, ultimately passed the Economic Recovery Program. At Geneva and at Havana the United States continued its reciprocal trade program under the provisions of the ITO.

While we individual citizens were losing faith for a "brave new world" with UN, our national Government was making progress in the basic factors of real peace-cooperative economic planning. It is easy to forget and difficult to remember the positive contributions toward world peace particularly when one often disposes that threats in the world are more often more dramatic and more menacing than ever.

It is easy, too, to say, "The United Nations won't work; we shall have another war. World government is a pipe dream." But we must have a world trade organization a continuing reality.
