### Crosstown Boulevard Link With Dowd Road Probable

#### Troops Bar Russians From Post In U.S. Zone

BERLIN (AP) — The U. S. Army, counter-attacking Russian restrictions in Berlin, turned back two Soviet generals and twenty other Russians today from a railroad administration building the Russians occupy in the U. S. sector of the city.

Fifty U. S. military policemen barred entrance to the building, which Russian officials in the U. S. zone, and the American guards permitted the Russian troops to enter the building.

The railroad building, near the border of the U. S.-Soviet sectors, has been occupied by Russian troops since late 1945 agreement. Similarly, the Russians occupy the Berlin radio station in the British Zone.

Col. James D. Howley, head of the U. S. Military Government in Berlin, said the American move was designed to block a Russian attack on the building after nightfall. The Russians refused to leave the building because it reports that the German elements were planning to destroy their stores.

Soviet Gen. Alexander Kolokolov protested that the American move frightened German in the neighborhood and incited them to attack the block. The Russian soldiers then moved to surround the block, but were turned back before reaching it.
