#### U. S. Being 'Embraced' With Debts

#### New Year Will Bring New Requirements To Citizens

Tomorrow, Jan. 1, 1950—the start of a new year and new half-century—will bring several changes into the verage Charlotte citizen's life.

In tabular form, these include:

1. A new gasoline tax. The State of North Carolina will begin collecting a penny more for each gallon of fue. sold. The additional tax will be used to retire \$200.000.000 in highway bonds with which the State is rebuilding its secondary road system.

2. A new Social Security (ax. Emuloyees will contribute 1 and 1/2 per cent (instead of the present 1 per cent) of their salaries to Uncle Sam. Emuloyers will askick in 1 1/2 per cent of the individual worker's pay instead of the 1 per cent they now say. Both deductions will go into the kitty from which the U. S. pays old age benefits.
