

World's Best Network in Japan Caled... Secrets Stolen In Tokyo, Relayed To Russia Helped Turn Tide Of War

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The Army warned today that remnants of a fabulous Russian spy ring that operated in Japan with perhaps the greatest daring and success in history may be at work in world capitals "at this very moment."

Army Cites Lesson For Americans

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The Army today issued the one Soviet spy ring operated with spectacular success during the war, and found in them a warning for Americans.

There is that fleetling hint at a present-day menace in the story of an espionage network so bold it slipped from the Japanese Cabinet and German embassy in Tokyo secrets that helped change the course of the war.

And there is another hint in a suggestion that the operator who tapped out coded messages on a secret radio might now be busy in some other country.

The Army snipped out parts of a 22,000-word report on the ring that Gen. Douglas MacArthur sent over from Tokyo. It gave "security sources" the story.

Labor Hearings Show 'Biased' NLRB Counsel

Denham was a witness before the committee earlier this week. At NLRB counsel, he is the Government's chief prosecutor before the Taft-Hartley Act.
