

Two Young Men Charged With Robbery

One Shot As Pair Nabbed In Capital Capture Made Near White House

WASHINGTON (AP)—Two youthful gunmen—one of them clad in a rakish zoot suit—confessed today to the daring Martinburg, W. Va., express train robbery.

Both men were armed when Washington police trapped them in the pawnshop. The arrests came barely fifteen hours after the holdup.

The two handily terrorized more than 100 passengers on the train and escaped with more than \$1,000 after shooting a clerk.

Police said they found \$200 on Ramondelli—an ex-Marine and about \$700 in small bills on Whittaker.
