TAX experts in Maryland have just completed an extensive survey of that, state's personal income tax structure. They verified what everyone suspected — that a third of Maryland's income tax revenue is the state of Maryland's income tax revenue is literally a tax on a tax. a levy on income taken from the taxpayer by the Federal income tax.

According to The Baltimore Sun, the experts examined 320,383 individual State income tax returns on which taxes of \$15,405,004 were levied. Then they computed the payments from the same returns if the taxpayers had been allowed deductions for their Federal payments. The result: the State would have coded only \$11,003,004.

This survey is of interest in North Carolina because we have heard, from time to time, suggestions that Tar Heel taxpayers should be allowed to deduct Federal [income levies in figuring their State income tax. None of the proposals has ever been entertained very seriously, since the y would knock a siteable hole in the general fund revenue.
