Congress refused to pass the law, and to this day has declined to authorize wire-tapping. Until Congress does so, the practice is utterly illegal and extremely dangerous, no matter what the Attorney-General of the United States thinks about it.

But it and when they do become generally available, there will be more than a little concern among arthritics and sufferers from rheumatism. Their question will be a difficult one to answer: should they allow themselves to be treated with cortisone and ACTH because they are suffering and can imagine no more painful condition than their present one.

Or will they reject the drugs upon the advice of the AMA's Council on Pharmacy. When, at the meeting last Summer of the International Congress for Rheumatic

Diseases, doctors presented a glowing pic-ture of the miracles worked by the two drugs, many sufferers from rheumatism and arthritis looked forward to Immediate relief or cure

At that time there were many warnings from many sources that complete tests with the two drugs had not been made. There were warnings that side effects might completely rule out use of the drugs. It appears that these warnings were cor-rect, that arthitics and rhematics must curb their enthusiasm. for the moment, at least.

The public, of course, will await eagerly a settlement of the dispute between the Arthritis and Rheumatism Foundation and the AMA's Council on Pharmacy.
