Single Police Agencies Are "Crime Free"

Institute Report Is Submitted

A centralized police agency, rather than the present two police departments, would be "an ideal" means of battling Charlotte's and Mecklenburg's crime, the Institute of Government said today.

W. M. Cochrane, assistant director of the Institute, was prepared to submit a report on consolidated police work at a joint session of the City Council and the County Commissioners this afternoon.

TO HEAR SUMMARY A number of bodies were scheduled to convene at 2:30 o'clock at City Hall to hear a summary of a 30,000-word report compiled by the Institute on local police and court work.

Mr. Cochrane, describing some of the conditions found during a long survey of the local departments, said the nearly 90 per cent of all arrests made in Mecklenburg are made within a seven-mile circle with the city of Charlotte as its core.

However, he pointed out, the decrease abruptly at the city limits, but continues at a high level in the unincorporated areas.

While the institute was making no definite recommendation on merger of the police work, Mr. Cochrane pointed out that the "ideal" centralized agency seemed to be the best solution.

Among the advantages of one county-wide department, he listed: 1. A single set of crime records. 2. One division of specialized experts.

4. One set of fingerprints. The summary of the Institute's detailed report follows:
