The main reason why neither the President nor Concress is willing to act now is that it would be politically unpopular to do so. Any adequate anti-inflation program, will have to involve more than price controls. Wages and salaries will have to be frozen. Cellings will have to be fixed for rents and profits. Hence, a complete program for controlling inflation at this stage would probably aliente merchants, labor, farmers, landiords, corporation executives, stockholders and everyone else in a position to protit from the first effects of inflation. If victory in Korsa were the only objective, our national economy could probably withstand the shock without the necessity of a complete program to control inflation. But the \$50 billion fixeur used by President Truman is just a starter. He has airready, said he, will ask for more money to arm other free nations. And it is entirely possible the hurried estimates of the cost of our own preparedness programs will prove to be too small.

Hence we reluctantly arrive at the conclusion that ultimate victory over world Communism will require early enactment of a rigid and complete control of all infaliationary forces in our national economy. We do not welcome the prospect, but see no other alternative.
