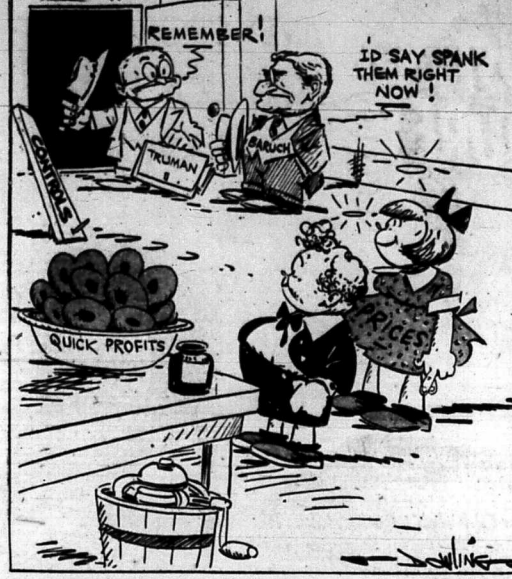

MORE ON PARKING

CHARLOTTE continues to grow in coming decades as it has in the past half century, it can be sure of one thing: the parking problem will become more serious as the city population increases...

In cities with less than 50,000 population, there are about 50 parking spaces for each 1,000 residents. In cities of 50,000 to 100,000 population, there are only 27 spaces...

Expressed another way, there are seven times as many parking spaces and thirteen times as many parked vehicles per 1,000 population in small cities as in large.

This trend is already evident in Charlotte. Every year upward of 100 new parking spaces are added to the city...

The results of inadequate parking facilities in the main business district are already being felt.
