TOP defense officials have been holding a series of secret meetings to prepare their budget estimates for Presi-dent Truman. Their recommendations will probably set the demestic economy for the next two years—how much taxes will be increased, how high prices and wages will rise, and whether rationing and price controls will be ordered.

The meetings are still continuing, site-steed by Secretary of Defense Marshall, Undersecretary Lovett and the John Chiefs of Staff However, estimates have now been trimmed down by \$10,000,000,000 and the military budget will be approximately \$40,000,000,000.

This will pay for about 80 air force groups, eightee army divisions and twelve to fifteen aircraft carriers. (This ten groups and two divisions less than originally playmed.)
