seribed in a News story Saturday is not yet known. It is known however, that the operation has proved tremendously valuable wherever used in the United States. It has brought new hope to the friends and relatives of a certain group of mental patients. The operation is not an effective treatment for all mental disorders. Dr. John McKee, superintendent of the State Hosepital at Morganion, points out that approximately 25 per cent of the patients at his hospital can be "helped" by the delicate brain operation. A representative at the State Haspital at Camp Butner thinks Dr. McKee is somewhat cautious in his estimation. Dr. James L. Cathell believe "between 20 and 23 per cent" of the State's mental patients can be helped.

Not all of those helped by pre-frontal lobotomy are "cured"—a risky word to use at any time in connection with mental liness. But some of them show such improvement that they can be returned to their families. Others show improvement
