

# President Cites Needs Of Security

Says Broader  
Controls Ahead

WASHINGTON—(AP)—President Truman today called on Congress to b

taxes this session by "much more" than the \$8,000,000 combined total of last two increases.

The President, in his annual economic message, notified the lawmakers that the nation's security will demand lending and spending auth-

ty totaling \$140,000,000 for this fiscal year and next. The present fiscal year runs out next July 1.

As he set it out, this total would be for actual military and foreign aid spending plus contractual lending and loan guaranteeing authority for national security purposes. Other Government expenditures would be in addition to this.

Mr. Truman said workers accept wage restraints and men must accept lower its — that no one should like his income to escape share of the higher tax burden. He told the legislators, too, 1,000,000 more men and

may be added to the armed forces within a few months. The military manpower goal has been a force of 3,200,000 by June 30, but only this figure was raised to 3,480,000. Congress voted a \$4,790,000

increase in individual and corporation taxes last Fall. In December it passed a bill to get \$3,300,000 more from corporations through "excess profits" tax and an increase in existing taxes.

Mr. Truman said it should be the first principle of public policy "to maintain a balanced budget to finance the cost of national defense."

He added:  
"Corporations should pay higher taxes. Individuals should pay much higher taxes. But taxes should be higher and extensive."
