TOKYO—(AP)—Swarms of Chinese Red troops pushed on southward tonight and menaced Wonju, important Allied escape highway center 55 miles east of Seoul.

General MacArthur's headquarters said seven Communist armies—perhaps 210,000 men — are moving from the Chunchon area toward Wonju.

They appagently aim to destroy United Nations forces there and then wheel west in an attempt to cut off Eighth Army units retreating down from ruined Seoul.
