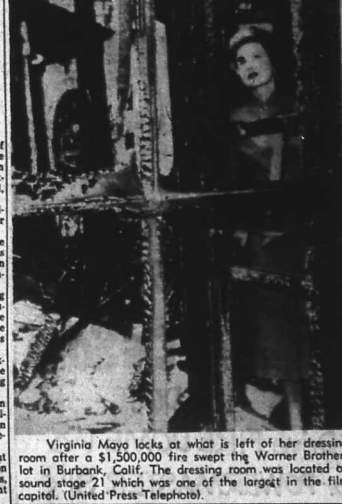

The original five-man truce team which began the talks last July 10 will leave the Far East June 9 to become superintendents of the U. S. Naval Academy. Harrison has been a member of the U. N. delegation since Jan. 23. Clark has not announced a replacement for Harrison.
