Red Threats of Korean Drive Worry Officials In Washington

WASHINGTON (AP) — Threatening Red hints of renewed large-scale warfare in Korea have been received in official Washington with deep seriousness.

They have sharpened the belief that the Chinese and North Korean armies, having built up a million-man force during the 11 months of truce talks, may now launch a major offensive.

The armistice negotiations stalled upon insistence by the United Nations Command that none of its Chinese and North Korean captives should be forced to go home, and upon a report of a surprise attack on these captives.

Red negotiators have been equally firm in rejecting voluntary repatriation and in denouncing the results of the survey.

WASHINGTON (AP) — President Truman today asked Congress for \$3,341,000,000 for a "major further expansion" of atomic production facilities.

The money, in the form of a supplemental appropriation, would go to the Atomic Energy Commission and the Tennessee Valley Authority.
