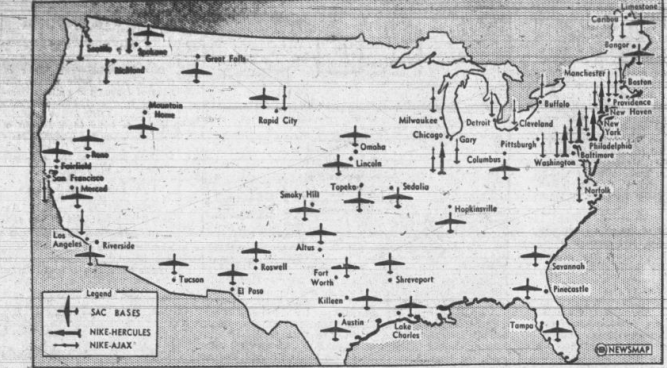


Midwest Pounded By Heavy Storms High Winds And Hail Scourge Area
