TOMATO-EGGPLANT CASSEROLE

1 medium onion 3 medium tomatoes
1 medium green pepper 1 teaspoon salt
2 medium eggplants Dash pepper
1/2 cup olive oil, salad oil 1 teaspoon sweet basil
or shortening. Few sprigs chopped parsley

Chop onion and green pepper fairly fine. Cut eggplants in 1/2-inch slices. Cook onion and pepper in 2 tablespoons oil or shortening until wilted. Remove from pan and set aside to use later on. Add remaining oil or shortening to skillet and brown eggplant slices on both sides.

Start your oven at 375F or moderate and grease a 1 1/2 quart casserole. Put layer of eggplant on bottom, cover with half the tomato slices, sprinkle with salt and pepper mixture, salt, pepper, basil. Repeat layers, ending with eggplant. Cover and bake 15 minutes or until eggplant is tender. Sprinkle with chopped parsley and serve to 6.

Fresh peaches now in season are an invitation to prepare fresh peach sherbet. Use these ingredients:

2 1/2 cup sweetened condensed milk
2 tablespoons lemon juice 1 cup crushed fresh peaches
2 tablespoons melted butter 2 egg whites

Blend the condensed milk, lemon juice, melted butter, and water. Add the peaches and mix. Beat the egg whites until they are stiff and fold them into the chilled mixture. Pour this into the freezing tray of the refrigerator and freeze until firm. The recipe will serve six.

Singer Wilton Clary Appearing at Airport

Wilton Clary, whose voice entertained thousands here in 1949, returned to Charlotte last night to sing again.

Clary, who played the leading role in the musical "Oklahoma" here in 1949, sang in the Dogwood Room of the Airport 77 Restaurant in the new terminal building.

He was brought there by the restaurant management as its part in the dedication ceremony to be held Saturday. Clary will sing twice nightly through Saturday night.

His songs included medleys from "Oklahoma!" and "Annie Get Your Gun," as well as folk songs and popular numbers.

Clary said he will leave here early Sunday morning for a three-week appearance in Toronto. There he will be featured artist in Toronto's "Melody Fair," will sing in "Oklahoma!" and "Finian's Rainbow."

He said he will concentrate on night club appearances because opportunities are greater in that field. Television he described as a "great field" but "tough to crack."

Stories From Girl's Killer Branded Lies

The brother of the victim in the Lucille Logan Rodriguez murder story here has branded the story of her convicted killer as "lies."

James H. Logan issued the statement today in light of the fact that Charlie Rhodes, who was sentenced to life in prison on June 20, 1953, for the slaying, has escaped prison.

Rhodes pleaded guilty to killing Mrs. Rodriguez on the night of June 5 at a home in Hoskins. He told police and Mecklenburg Superior court that he and Mrs. Rodriguez were childhood sweethearts.

HUSBAND IN GERMANY

Mrs. Rodriguez married a Mexican-American soldier, who was stationed in Germany at the time of the slaying.

Mrs. Rodriguez's brother, Mr. Logan, recently returned to Charlotte after having spent three years in the tuberculosis sanatorium at Me-Cain.

Logan said he was unable to make any denial of Rhodes' statements at the time of the slaying last year. But now since he has returned and Rhodes has escaped he said he feels he should issue a statement.

He said, "The story that Charlie Rhodes told police and the newspapers about my sister, Lucille, was a complete lie. All the things he said about going with her, meeting her in bars, going berry picking with her, and things like that aren't so."
