



Israeli Chief Calls Secret Conference

JERUSALEM — Premier David Ben-Gurion, in an unprecedented break of the Jewish Sabbath, summoned his cabinet into a top secret meeting today.

Although it was obvious the meeting was concerned with the Israeli withdrawal from the Gaza Strip and the Gulf of Aqaba, it was shrouded in the deepest secrecy. No official was in a position to say why the cabinet had so unexpectedly been called to gether.

Reports that a meeting between UNRWA Commander Maj. Gen. E. L. M. Burns and Israeli Army chief of Staff Maj. Gen. Moshe Dayan, set for this afternoon, had been postponed until tomorrow, sparked rumors the cabinet is reconsidering the withdrawal. But Israeli officials said that was "mere speculation."

NEW ELECTION

Only a short time earlier, a spokesman for the nationalist Herut — opposition — party demanded that Ben-Gurion's government resign and order new elections.

In a case of renewed Egyptian belligerency," he said, "the United States will not lift a finger to defend Israel."

He declared deputies who voted in favor of withdrawal when the question comes before parliament next week would commit treason and be blacklisted.

THE OPPONENTS

The Herut Party is the government's chief opposition. Criticism was voiced also, however, within two small parties of Ben-Gurion's five-party coalition. Leaders of Labor Union and the United Workers Party talked of quitting the coalition because of dissatisfaction over the Gaza-Aqaba policy.

A meeting scheduled at Lydda Airport outside Tel Aviv today between Maj. Gen. E. L. M. Burns, U. N. emergency force chief, and Maj. Gen. Moshe Dayan, Israeli Army chief of staff, to discuss technicalities relating to the withdrawal was postponed until tomorrow. It was assumed here the postponement was to allow Burns and Dayan additional time to consult with their staffs.

Most Male Teachers Here Hoping To Quit

Only 14 Of 103 Are Sure They'll Stick

Only 14 of 103 male school teachers in Charlotte and Mecklenburg are positive they'll stick with the profession here in September.

The 14 were among 103 of 174 city-county male teachers who answered a detailed questionnaire this week.

And the reason they hope to leave the profession is summed up in one word — "Money."

The questionnaire was sent out by the Myers Park Schoolmasters' Club preceding a called meeting for all city-county male teachers Tuesday.

Won't Boost Profession

The answers also revealed other significant facts about the attitude of the male teacher here.

Overwhelming majorities of male teachers said they would not recommend the profession in North Carolina to young men starting college.

If the male teacher had to do all over again, he would not choose the teaching profession.

More than half the teachers felt — because of preoccupation with financial responsibilities, uncertainties, etc. — they were not doing a good job.

Nearly all the male teachers hold other jobs, some having as many as six outside the classroom.

Nearly all the male teachers cannot live on their teacher pay alone.

The Myers Park group is headed by Gus Purcell, a Myers Park High School teacher and coach. Other officers are vice president Fred Sitton and secretary-treasurer Julian Helms.

Male teachers have been asked to attend a meeting in the Myers Park High School library Tuesday at 4 o'clock to discuss the current teaching situation and how the male teacher fits into the picture," Purcell said.

50 Serious About Leaving

This is a tabulation of answers to the questionnaire:

- Q: Are you seriously considering leaving the teaching profession?

(It is significant, however, that only 14 of the 103 answering these two questions answered "no" to both questions, indicating only 14 male teachers are certain they will remain in the profession here.)

- Q: Considering the present tenure and salary schedule, would you recommend the teaching profession in North Carolina to a young man starting to college?

Biggest Complaint: Money

The reason given by practically all the teachers for their unhappiness was "Financial."

A few complained about parents, administrative details, hours, etc.

One question read: "If suddenly your family were dependent solely on your teaching salary, could you in fairness to them remain in the teaching profession?"

Out of 103 answers, only 12 said they could remain, 68 said they could not and 23 were undecided.

A question on outside work showed nearly all worked at least one outside-the-classroom position. Some worked at as many as six, they said. Some of these multiple jobs, however, entail coaching duties for some male teachers who are paid extra for that. Others work on Saturdays and many during holidays. Thirty-nine of the teachers said they had one outside position, 18 hold two positions and 16 hold four to six.

Not Doing Effective Job

Financial worries and other uncertainties, including outside obligations, the teachers said, cut down on their effectiveness in the classroom. Consequently, 56 of 100 answering the question said they were not contributing "maximum effectiveness to the education of pupils" in their classroom. Twenty-two said they felt they were and 22 were undecided.

None of the teachers answering the questionnaire favored a proposed "merit system" for teachers' salaries administered by the principal.

Only 12 teachers thought the 9.31 per cent pay increase proposed by the Advisory Budget Commission would make a "big difference" in their present or future economic security. Eighty-six thought it would not, and five were undecided.

Other facts culled from the questionnaire: Nearly half the married male teachers have wives who work.

Nearly all seeking summer employment, most of it in non-professional fields.

Of those answering this question, 22 worked in professional fields, 14 in highly skilled labor, 38 in low skilled.
