189. Talkativeness.—n. 1. Babblativeness, gabbaciousness (blend of "gab" and "loquaciousness"), gabbiness, gift of gab or blarney, hot air, jawgraphy, jawkativeness, medicine tongue, oral calisthenics, speakativeness, speechification, talkiness, windiness. Spec. barbering, talking at length.

2. IDLE TALK CHATTER. Air, babble-babble, baked wind, balloon juice, bibble and babble, bibble-babble, blah-blah, blat, blate, blib-blab, blibberblabber, blibber-blubber, blub, blubber, bosh, breeze, buzz, buzz-buzz, bzzzbzzz, cackle, chatter-chitter, chin-chin, chitter and chatter, chitterchatter, clitter-clatter, dribble, dribble-drabble, drool, escape of gas, flubdub, flubdub and guff, froth, gab, gaff, gas, gassing, gibble and gabble, gibblegabble, giffle-gaffle, gubble, guff, gush, hot air, jibber, jibber and jabber, jibber-jabber, jingle-jangle, jive, mag, mulligatawny, mumbo-jumbo, noise, patter, pibble-pabble, pitter-patter, prit-prat, prittle-prattle, rimble-ramble, smoke, south wind ("hot air"), talk-talk, talkee-talkee, talkie-talkie, talkytalk, talky-talky, twitter-twatter, twit-twat, wind, yabber, yap. Spec. all jaw, nothing but talk; blare and blather, noise and voluble nonsense; slipslap, slipslop, slopdash, twattle, wish-wash, weak or silly chatter, twaddle; all talk and no cider, a great deal of talk and no results; hop talk, hot air, talking through one's hat, engaging in improbable or fanciful statements.
