Team-Teaching Tried in School

SAN FRANCISCO (UPI) — A number of California elementary schools are trying something new — team teaching.

Ordinarily, each classroom is a self-contained unit. One teacher is responsible for all or nearly all of the day's teaching and activities.

A team — teaching plan works this way: Four teachers team in work with about 115 children, approximately the total of their four classroom enrollments.

One teacher might have a special talent for science and arithmetic. Another's forte might be language arts. A third might specialize in social studies, a fourth in creative arts.

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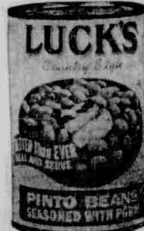
