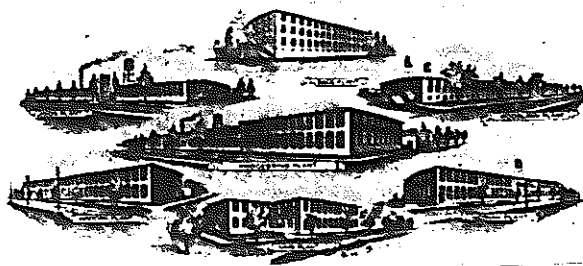
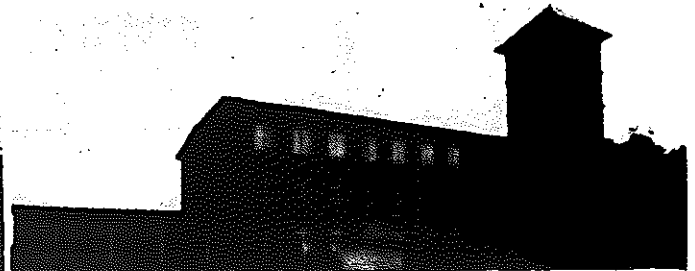
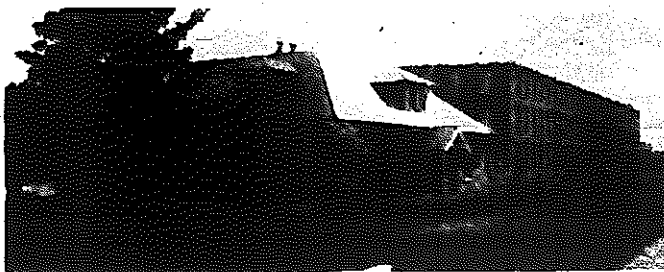


These pictures present mills from the Gossett, Calhoun and Chadwick-Hoskins groups, located at Anderson, and Calhoun Falls, S. C., and Charlotte, N. C. These mills manufacture print cloths, broad-cloths, sheetings, jeans, combed and carded lawns, voiles, pongees, surgical

gauze, carded sales yarn, spun rayon and a wide range of rayon fabrics. A total of 275,000 ring spindles and 6,566 looms are used in these plants and employ 4,000 workers. B. B. Gossett, well known local resident, is president and treasurer of this group of mills.

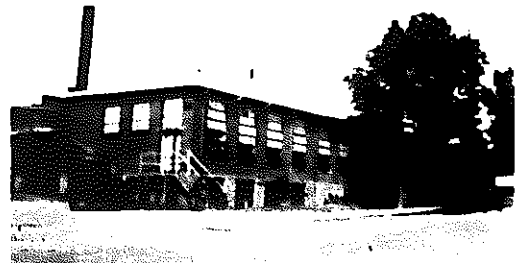
