A Last Resort Weapon Against Inflation Pops Up

There are three ways of looking at inflation and if the money experts know what they are talking about the time is at hand when every individual must de-cide which view he is going to take.

The first, and probably the most com-mon, expedient is not to look at it at all. This entails a sort of blind indecision— a floundering about that produces noth-ing except mutual and collective help-

Then there is the patriotic, public-splitted approach to dealing with inflation, Obviously, this is the road the Administration would have us follow, we are used to buy Government bonds or put our money in the bank instead of spending it for goods that we could get along without, we are asked to give over convent to higher taxes, to reduce get along without. We are asked to give our consent to higher stars, to reduce our standard of living so that competi-tive buying will not drive prices up. We are cautioned to get out of debt and stay out. We are advised that if we do these things and have faith in the Government to take care of its mounting deficit, inflation will never come and our insurance, bonds, and aavings will be safe.

The third course of action against inflation is essentially selfish, hardheaded, and skeptical. It is the reaction of the practical business man who, having decided that the Government either can't or won't atop inflation, looks about him for ways of safeguarding his own investments and riding out the storm. It is a philosophy of hedging. The Wall Street Journal is printing a series of articles that should prove very helpful to those who accept inflation as inevitable. The advice it sats forth is just the opposite of that given out by the Oovernment. If you want to beat inflation, so into deel: Borrow on your insurance and invest in commodities and business property. (Farms are not desirable.) Don't get loaded with cash and accounter receivables. Steer clear of all bonds.
