WASHINGTON — The food-stamp plan, by which surplus farm commodities are distributed to relief of the nation's grocery stores, has received a remarkable vote of confidence in the Senate, which gives this experiment a unique status among New Deal activities.

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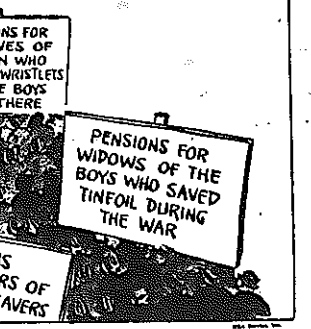
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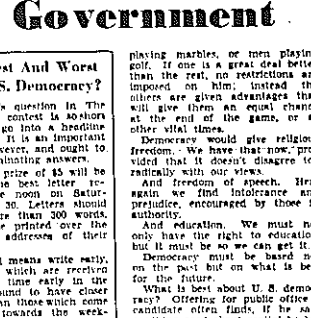
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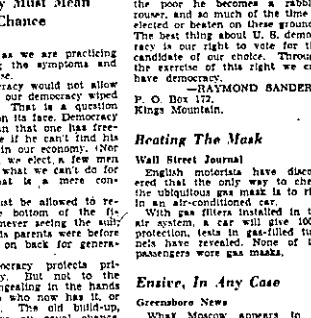
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
