Dutch Put Up Gallant Fight BATAVIA, N.E.I. — (AP) — Invasion here captured the little oil-producing island of Tarakan off northeast Borneo but a stubbornly fighting little Dutch garrison held them off until all oil fields and all equipment were thoroughly demolished. It was announced officially late tonight.

It said the Japanese had poured onto Tarakan, literally overrunning it, and a communique said only remnants of the garrison escaped to the mainland.
