A Republican Party already rejuvenated by spectacular election gains in United States Senate seats and state governorship—steadily swelled its minority power in the House of the new Congress today, and after mid-day a Republican sweep to majority control remained a mathematical possibility.

Dewey to the Governorship in a sweep which enhanced his chances for the 1944 Republican Presidential nomination.
