She was the fourth submarine reported lost or missing by the Navy Department since the war began.

Loss of Perch, commissioned Nov. 19, 1936, had a length overall of 300 feet, 4 inches, a beam of 26 feet, 6 inches, a displacement of 1,330 tons.
