Union Calls F. R.'s Plan To Settle Fight Unfair

Time Is Running Out Rapidly By Associated Press Walkouts in the soft coal mines swept toward an industry tie-up today and John L. Lewis' United Mine Workers told President Roosevelt his plan for settlement of their wage dispute through the War Labor Board is unfair to a half million of America's finest industrial workers.

"Our every request" could only be denied by the W. L. B., the Miners' Policy Committee at New York told the President in reply to his appeal for uninterrupted production in the interest of war production. It called instead for a renewal of collective bargaining.
