Largest Force Of Bombers Of The War Used

Greatest Weight Of British Bombs Concentrated On Duesseldorf

LONDON—(AP)—The RAF, resuming its deadly effensive against the armament centers of the Reich, sent the greatest force of heavy bombers of the war to attack several targets in the Ruhr and Rhineland last night, concentrating its greatest deluge of bombs on Dusseldorf, it was announced today.
