## Americans Fly **Unescorted To** Make Attack

Daylight Assault Follows Great RAF Night Attack on Krefeld

LONDON—(AP)—Flying Fortresses flew unescorted into the Ruhr for the first time today to attack the Huls synthetic rubber plant at Recklinghausen while another formation attacked the former General Motors plant at Antwerp, a United States communique said tonight.

Twenty bombers were lost, but the Fortresses shot down "a considerable number" of attacking enemy planes. The daylight raids followed a pulverizing RAF night attack on Krefeld, an industrial city in the Ruhr. Recklinghausen is about 30 miles northeast of Krefeld.
