The bombing news looks good, but the hard fact is that this is a critical stage in the campaign. The Germans are putting up a terrific resistance. It is just barely possible that this is the path of Allied bombers...

As has been already disclosed, Germany has switched her emphasis to the production of fighters. Increasing numbers of them are stationed in the path of Allied bombers...

CONGRESS has not, I think, acted in a statesmanlike, unselfish and disinterested manner in the President's criticism. The country would have welcomed an equally-able administrative structure...
